## GENERAL EMPLOYMENT

### REGISTRATION AND TEMPORARY RESIDENCE AND WORK PERMIT

1	<b>Application Form MGEN2.</b>
2	Copy of a <b>valid passport</b> , or relevant travel document, with validity period of at least 6 months beyond the requested work permit.
3	Original <b>results of medical blood tests</b> to ensure that the third-country national does not suffer from hepatitis B and C, HIV, syphilis, and chest X-ray for tuberculosis, valid for up to 4 months from the issuing date, from the country of origin, duly certified. *
4	Original <b>Certificate of Clear Criminal Record</b> from the country of origin (if the applicant resides in a country other than the country of origin, the certificate must come from the country of residence) with effect of up to 6 months from the issuing date, duly certified.*
5	<b>Health Insurance Certificate</b> covering primary and secondary medical care and repatriation of mortal remains (Plan A). <b>Or</b> <b>Certificate of registration with the GeSY</b> and private insurance to cover the costs of transportation of mortal remains.
6	<b>Emigrants of Greek origin (Omogenis):</b> Copy of the Identity Card for Omogenis (applies only to the holder and not to other members of his family). <b>Syrians of Cretan Origin/Kurds:</b> A copy of the list approved by the Ministry of Interior, showing the applicants' name (applies only to the holder and not to other members of his family).*
7	<b>Employer's Liability Insurance</b> with automatic renewal.
8	<b>Declaration to cover the cost of repatriation</b> of the third-country national.
9	<b>Declaration of Mailing Address</b> for the third-country national.

\*The submission of a sealed contract from the Department of Labour is required only in the case where the applicant has not the approval from the Civil Registry and Migration Department for free access to the labour market.
