## **GENERAL EMPLOYMENT**

## **REGISTRATION AND TEMPORARY RESIDENCE AND WORK PERMIT**

1	Application Form MGEN2.
2	Copy of a <b>valid passport</b> , or relevant travel document, with validity period of at least 6 months beyond the requested work permit.
3	<b>Copy of the passport's page</b> , or relevant travel document's, indicating the latest arrival in the Republic.
4	Original <b>results of medical blood tests</b> to ensure that the third-country national does not suffer from hepatitis B and C, HIV, syphilis, and chest X-ray for tuberculosis, valid for up to 4 months from the issuing date, from the country of origin, carried out in the Republic.
5	Original <b>Certificate of Clear Criminal Record</b> from the country of origin (if the applicant resides in a country other than the country of origin, the certificate must come from the country of residence) with effect of up to 6 months from the issuing date, duly certified.*
6	<ul> <li>Health Insurance Certificate covering primary and secondary medical care and transportation of mortal remains (Plan A).</li> <li>Or</li> <li>Certificate of registration with the GHS and private health insurance to cover the costs of transportation of mortal remains.</li> <li>Or</li> <li>Letter from the Diocese that it assumes responsibility for medical care, repatriation costs, employer's liability insurance and accommodation.</li> </ul>
7	Letter from the Diocese regarding the employment of the priest, indicating the salary he will be receiving.
8	Declaration to cover the repatriation of the third-country national.
9	Declaration of Mailing Address for the third-country national.
