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Introduction

In Europe, migration continues to be an area of great importance that has greatly affected the EU and will continue to do so for years to come. Each EU Member State has its own concerns about migration; however, there are also many common issues and shared challenges. A practical and effective way of managing migration includes joint and coordinated approaches between countries.

The EU funds provide EU financial contributions to strengthen the area of freedom, security and justice and to develop the common EU policy on asylum and immigration based on solidarity. The funds run for a period of 7 years (2014–2020) and are designed to be flexible and responsive to both the common and the individual migration-related challenges and opportunities faced by the EU.

What follows is a selection of projects implemented by the Member States under the [Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund](#).

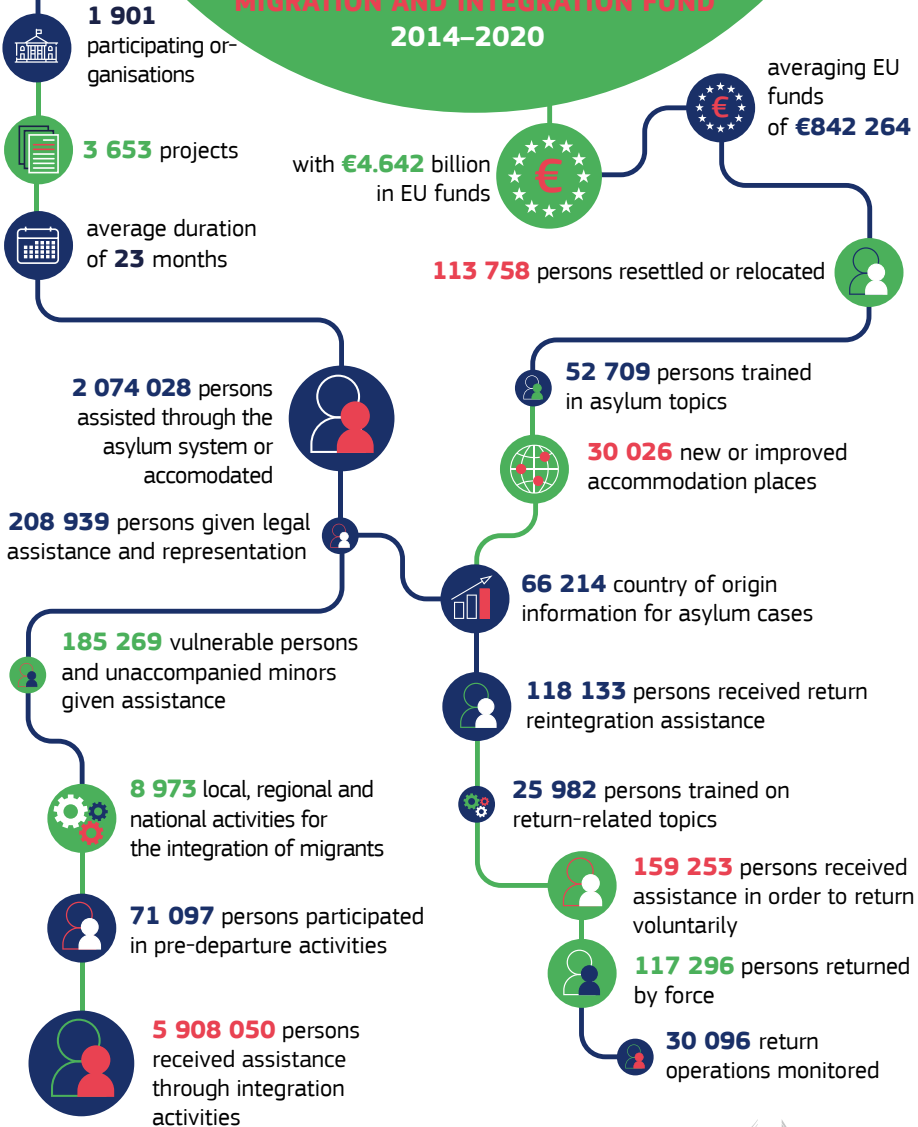

5 YEARS OF FUND FACTS

FROM THE MEMBER STATE NATIONAL PROGRAMMES UNDER THE ASYLUM, MIGRATION AND INTEGRATION FUND 2014–2020



European Commission

The Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF) was set up for the 2014–2020 period, with a total of EUR 4.642 billion for those 7 years. It promotes the efficient management of migration flows and the implementation, strengthening and development of a common EU approach to asylum and immigration. The fund has four specific objectives, as follows.

- **Asylum.** Strengthening and developing the **Common European Asylum System** by ensuring that EU legislation in this field is efficiently and uniformly applied.
- **Legal migration and integration.** Supporting legal migration to EU Member States in line with labour market needs and promoting the effective **integration** of non-EU nationals.
- **Return.** Enhancing fair and effective return strategies, which contribute to combating **irregular migration**, with an emphasis on the sustainability and effectiveness of the return process.
- **Solidarity.** Making sure that the Member States that are most affected by migration and asylum flows can count on solidarity from the rest of the EU.

There are special financial incentives to support the **EU resettlement programme**, including a focus on common EU priorities and on **relocation measures** for transferring asylum applicants from Member States that have high migratory pressures to other Member States.

ACHIEVING THE KEY OBJECTIVES

The fund is divided into two parts: funds managed directly by the Commission and funds managed by the Member States (known as shared management).

Funds under **shared management represent the largest share** of the AMIF (approximately 88 %). Member States implement their multiannual national programmes covering the whole of 2014 to 2020. These programmes are prepared, implemented, monitored and evaluated by the relevant authorities in the Member States, in partnership with the relevant stakeholders, including civil society organisations.

THE FUND BENEFICIARIES

All the Member States except Denmark participate in the implementation of the AMIF. Examples of beneficiaries of the programmes include state and federal authorities, local public bodies, non-governmental organisations (NGOs), humanitarian organisations, private and public law companies, education organisations and research organisations.

AMIF project: Asyl-Train (AT/2017/PR/1009)

The increased number of asylum claims in recent years – especially in 2015 – have placed a considerable burden on the Austrian asylum system. In this context, the **Asyl-Train** project offered capacity building in the areas of **identifying trafficked persons** and acquiring **intercultural skills**.

The project aimed to raise awareness among asylum-relevant stakeholders of human traf-

ficking in order to enable them to identify trafficked persons more quickly and to improve their intercultural skills so that their interactions with asylum seekers would be more culturally sensitive and efficient.

Under the umbrella of the project a total of 39 training sessions were held, in all Austrian provinces.

AMIF-Projekt: ASYL-Train (AT/2017/PR/1009)

Die gesteigerte Anzahl an Asylanträgen in den letzten Jahren – insbesondere im Jahr 2015 – belastet das österreichische Asylsystem stark. In diesem Zusammenhang zielt das Projekt **Asyl-Train** auf den Aufbau von Kapazitäten in den Bereichen der **Identifizierung von Betroffenen von Menschenhandel** sowie der **Verstärkung interkultureller Kompetenzen** ab.

Das Ziel des Projekts ist es, österreichische Akteure für das Thema Menschenhandel zu sensibilisieren, um Betroffene rascher identifizieren zu können, sowie ihre interkulturellen Kompetenzen aufzubauen bzw. zu verstärken, um die Interaktionen mit Asylwerbern und Asylwerberinnen kultursensibler und effizienter gestalten zu können.

Insgesamt werden in den beiden Bereichen 39 Trainings in allen Bundesländern Österreichs im Rahmen des Projekts als mobile Maßnahme angeboten.



AMIF project: Quantensprung II (AT/2017/PR/2009)

The Quantensprung II project aimed to improve access to the labour market for the participants (third-country nationals with a long-term residence permit, persons entitled to asylum and beneficiaries of subsidiary protection). The project supported the target group in overcoming obstacles in order to reduce systematic discrimination in the labour market. To reach that goal, the project provided the following modular -based activities and measures:

1. language courses specially designed to facilitate participation in the labour market;
2. mentoring programmes and activities in order to raise awareness of application procedures;
3. measures to support the target group in establishing new contacts with prospective employers and gaining experience in various professions.

AMIF-Projekt: Quantensprung II (AT/2017/PR/2009)

Das Projekt Quantensprung II hat die Verbesserung des nachhaltigen Zugangs für die Teilnehmer (Drittstaatsangehörige mit längerfristiger Aufenthaltsperspektive, Asylberechtigte und subsidiär Schutzberechtigte) zum Arbeitsmarkt zum Ziel. Angesetzt wird an identifizierten Hürden, welche systematische Benachteiligung der Zielgruppenangehörigen am Arbeitsmarkt bedingen. Eine Reihe ineinandergreifender Maßnahmen wird bedarfsgerecht in modular kombi-

nierbarer Form angeboten, welche sich zu den folgenden Clustern zusammenfassen lassen:

1. Maßnahmen zur Vermittlung von Fachsprachenkenntnissen,
2. Orientierungsmaßnahmen zu Bewerbungsverfahren und Abläufen in österreichischen Betrieben,
3. Maßnahmen zur Unterstützung bei dem Knüpfen relevanter Kontakte und dem Sammeln von Erfahrung in den angestrebten Berufssparten.



AMIF project: Gender-based violence and asylum: an integrated approach (BE/2018/PR/2528)

This project's general objective was to improve the identification of and support for persons who have suffered gender-based violence (GBV) (physical, psychological and/or sexual) throughout the asylum reception network. Several activities were planned, including the finalisation of the implementation of the path towards eliminating female genital mutilation developed in the previous AMIF 15-06 project, the participatory development of an approach integrating the fights against the different forms of GBV, the creation of educational (video) tools, the

organisation of training sessions for GBV reference persons and a national symposium.

Such an integrated anti-GBV strategy did not yet exist, and the project was therefore innovative. At the national level, its application was to allow better identification and monitoring of GBV victims throughout the asylum reception network. If the project receives a positive evaluation, its results could also be disseminated at the European level.

Projet AMIF: Violence basée sur le genre et asile: une approche intégrée (VBG & Asile) (BE/2018/PR/2528)

L'objectif général du projet est d'améliorer l'identification et l'accompagnement des personnes qui ont subi des violences basées sur le genre (VBG) (physiques, psychologiques et/ou sexuelles) dans tout le réseau d'accueil. Plusieurs activités sont envisagées dans le cadre de ce projet, entre autres la finalisation de la mise en œuvre de la trajectoire MGF (mutilation génitale féminine) élaborée dans le cadre du projet AMIF 15-06, l'élaboration de manière participative d'une trajectoire intégrée reprenant différentes formes de violences basées sur le genre, la création des outils didactiques

(vidéo), l'organisation des formations des personnes ressources VBG ainsi que d'un colloque national, etc.

Une telle trajectoire intégrée de prise en charge des VBG n'existe pas encore. Sa mise en œuvre est donc particulièrement innovante. Au niveau national, son application visait à permettre une meilleure identification et un meilleur suivi des victimes de VBG dans tout le réseau d'accueil de l'asile. Au niveau européen, le projet pourra être disséminé sous réserve d'une évaluation positive.



AMIF project: Integration and citizenship of asylum seekers (BE/2016/PR/1570)

The department for the training of asylum seekers creates, organises and provides training modules. The objective of these modules is to maintain and further develop asylum seekers' skills, by providing them with key information in order to allow them to better handle the challenges of the migration process in which they are involved. Autonomy, responsibility and coexistence are at the core of the issues addressed during the training. The ultimate aim is to provide people with the will and motivation to take charge of their lives. The modules are conducted in French and in the native language of the people involved. Special attention is also paid to more vulnerable target groups, through the development of specific modules for unac-

companied minors, women and persons with low levels of education.

Projet AMIF: Intégration et citoyenneté des demandeurs d'asile (BE/2016/PR/1570)

Le service «Formation des demandeurs d'asile» crée, organise et dispense des modules de formation. Ces modules ont pour but de maintenir et de développer les compétences de ces personnes en leur proposant des clés de compréhension qui leur permettent de mieux faire face aux défis du parcours migratoire auquel elles ont pris part. L'autonomie, la responsabilité et le vivre-ensemble sont au cœur des questions abordées au cours de la formation. La finalité poursuivie est d'insuffler le désir et la motivation de garder ou de reprendre en main les rênes de sa vie. Ces modules sont donnés en français et dans la langue maternelle des personnes. Une attention particulière est accordée aux publics plus vulnérables en développant

des modules spécifiques pour les mineurs non accompagnés, les femmes et les personnes peu scolarisées.



AMIF project: Training and counselling of third-country nationals (BG/2017/PR/0003)



This project supports third-country nationals legally residing in Bulgaria and persons seeking asylum or who have been granted international protection in their social, economic and cultural integration. Through the project third-country nationals receive relevant information on the legal rights and obligations pertaining to their stay in Bulgaria and increase their knowledge of services and competent authorities in social, educational, health, employment and other areas.

Activities. Providing consultations and information to improve integration, social orientation and cultural adaptation conditions, support for professional development etc. and training courses in the Bulgarian language for third-country nationals, including those receiving international protection in Sofia and Bourgas.

Results. Improving the integration conditions, social inclusion and careers of third-country

nationals; improving their ability to understand and communicate in Bulgarian.

AMIF проект: Обучение и консултиране на законни мигранти и граждани на трети страни (ГТС) (BG/2017/PR/0003)

Целта на проекта е да предостави подкрепа на граждани на трети страни (ГТС), пребиваващи законно в България, както и на лица, търсещи/получили международна закрила, за улесняване на социалната, икономическата и културната им интеграция. В рамките на проекта ГТС получават информация за законните права и задължения, свързани с пребиваването им в България, и се запознават с услугите и компетентните органи в социалната, образователната, здравната, трудовата и други области.

Дейности: предоставяне на консултации и информация, за подобряване на условията за интеграция, социална ориентация и културна адаптация, подкрепа за професионално развитие и др.; провеждане на курсове по български език на ГТС, вклю-



чително на лица, получили международна закрила в гр. София и гр. Бургас.

Резултати: подобряване на условията за интеграция на ГТС, социалното им включване и успешна реализация, подобряване на способностите им за разбиране и комуникиране на български език.



AMIF project: A tolerant society for the integration of asylum seekers (BG/2017/PR/0005)

The project aimed to raise awareness in Bulgaria, the host society, about third-country nationals and to develop tolerance and positive attitudes towards persons seeking international protection, along with the effective integration of these persons into public life in Bulgaria.

Activities. Conducting a national information campaign targeted at persons seeking international protection and at the host society that included the development and dissemination of informative materials and videos, TV discussions, regional round-table conferences and a national conference; it also included holding a concert, cinema screenings and sporting events in the accommodation centres for asylum seekers.

Results. The project contributed to the successful integration and socialisation of 1 116 persons and to the development of positive attitudes and tolerance in the host society.

AMIF проект: Толерантно общество за интеграция на лицата, търсеци убежище (BG/2017/PR/0005)

Проектът цели повишаване на нивото на информираност на приемащото общество в България относно гражданите на трети страни и пълноценна интеграция на лицата, търсеци международна закрила (ЛТМЗ), в обществения живот на страната.

Дейности: провеждане на национална информационна кампания, насочена към ЛТМЗ и към приемащото общество, която включва изготвяне и разпространение на информационни материали и видеоматериали, провеждане на дискусии, телевизионни предавания, регионални кръгли маси и национална конференция; провеждане на концерт, кинопрожекции и спортни мероприятия в центровете за настаняване на бежанци.

Резултати: проектът допринесе за създаването на условия за пълноценна

интеграция в обществения живот на 1116 лица и за развитието на положителни нагласи и толерантност сред приемащото общество.



AMIF project: Psychosocial services and support for applicants for international protection (HR/2019/PR/0001)

This project addressed the key challenge of assisting applicants for international protection in their everyday lives by providing social and healthcare services developed in line with their needs.

The main activities included supporting applicants for international protection in their reception and accommodation, providing individual and group psychosocial support, organising play areas for children, assisting in healthcare and education, assisting schoolchildren, maintaining hygienic conditions at the reception centre, assisting vulnerable groups, communicating with the local community and procuring various kinds of aid and medicine.

The expected results included improved reception conditions at the reception centre, an established system to respond to the needs of vulnerable groups and communication with the local community to prevent discrimination.

Applicants for international protection are accommodated in reception centres in two locations and it is necessary to ensure appropriate psychosocial care and cultural and social orientation, organise leisure activities and teach personal hygiene.

AMIF Projekt: Psihosocijalne usluge i podrška tražiteljima međunarodne zaštite (HR/2019/PR/0001)



Ključan izazov jest pružanje pomoći tražiteljima međunarodne zaštite u svakodnevnom životu pružanjem socijalnih i zdravstvenih usluga, razvijenih u skladu s njihovim potrebama.

društvenu orijentaciju, organizirati provođenje slobodnog vremena te ih učiti higijenskim navikama.

Glavne aktivnosti uključuju pružanje podrške pri prijemu i smještaju tražitelja međunarodne zaštite, individualnu i grupnu psihosocijalnu podršku, održavanje dječjih igraonica, pomoć u zdravstvenoj skrbi i obrazovanju, pomaganje djeci školskog uzrasta, održavanje higijene u prihvatilištu, pomaganje ranjivim skupinama, komunikaciju s lokalnom zajednicom te nabavu pomagala i lijekova.

Tražitelji međunarodne zaštite smještaju se na dvije lokacije te je za njih potrebno osigurati odgovarajuću psihosocijalnu skrb, kulturno-

AMIF project: Disease prevention, psychological support and aid (HR/2018/PR/0008)



This project tackled the key challenges of health protection and disease prevention among applicants for international protection by ensuring access to primary healthcare medical appointments.

The main activities included initial examinations of newly arrived applicants, ensuring psychiatric assessments and consultation, providing health consultation in reception centres, transporting and accompanying patients to health institutions, providing information on disease prevention and family planning by producing leaflets and organising workshops and ensuring interpreters were present when patients used healthcare services.

The expected results included the protection of applicants' health and the availability of hygiene and healthcare information and of interpreters when providing healthcare and information.

Access to healthcare is one of the major problems that applicants for international protection

face, and not treating conditions until they have become urgent may harm public health, as well as incur higher expenses.

AMIF Projekt: Prevencija bolesti, psihološka podrška i pomoć (HR/2018/PR/0008)

Ključni izazovi projekta su zaštita zdravlja te prevencija bolesti kod tražitelja međunarodne zaštite osiguravanjem pristupa medicinskim konzultacijama na razini primarne zdravstvene zaštite.

Glavne aktivnosti uključuju prve zdravstvene preglede novopristiglih tražitelja međunarodne zaštite, osiguravanje psihijatrijskih pregleda i savjetovanja, pružanje zdravstvenih konzultacija u prihvatilištima, prijevoz pacijenata i njihove pratnje u zdravstvene ustanove na preglede, pružanje informacija o prevenciji bolesti i planiranju obitelji putem letaka i radionicama

te osiguravanje usluga prevođenja pri korištenju zdravstvenih usluga.

Očekivani rezultati su osiguranje zdravstvene zaštite tražiteljima međunarodne zaštite, informiranje o higijeni i zdravstvenoj skrbi te pružanje usluga prevođenja prilikom pružanja zdravstvene zaštite i informiranja.

Pristup zdravstvenoj skrbi jedan je od velikih problema s kojima se suočavaju tražitelji međunarodne zaštite, a liječenje stanja nakon što postanu hitna može štetiti javnom zdravlju, kao i iziskivati veće troškove.



AMIF project: Establishment and operation of a centre for unaccompanied third-country minors (CY/2018/PR/059)

The centre hosts and offers multidimensional services to a maximum of 45 unaccompanied minors, who are under the legal guardianship of the Director of the Social Welfare Services.

The services provided are grouped under the three main pillars of operation of the shelters: rehabilitation services, integration services and sustainable solution services.

In detail, the centre aims to provide unaccompanied children with a set of interdisciplinary and holistic services, such as psychological, social and legal counselling and support, services for integration and inclusiveness in public education, sexual education workshops and courses on Greek, English, music and physical education run by the project partner, the Municipal Multipurpose Centre of Nicosia. The centre's services are based on models that are considered to be good practice in other Member States and adapted for the situation in Cyprus.

The project sought to address key challenges such as the difficulty for minors in comprehending and interpreting the migration and asylum framework and procedures, the slow and time-consuming nature of the processes for examining applications due to the continually rising number of unaccompanied minors and the problems of interpreting, translation and rehabilitation faced by minors during their transition to adulthood.

AMIF έργο: Δημιουργία και λειτουργία κέντρου για ασυνόδευτους ανηλίκους τρίτων χωρών (CY/2018/PR/059)



Το Κέντρο φιλοξενεί και προσφέρει πολύπλευρες υπηρεσίες σε μέγιστο αριθμό 45 ασυνόδευτων ανηλίκων που βρίσκονται υπό τη νόμιμη κηδεμονία της Διευθύντριας των Υπηρεσιών Κοινωνικής Ευμερίας.

Οι παρεχόμενες υπηρεσίες μπορούν να διαχωριστούν σε τρεις κύριους πυλώνες που αποτελούν τον μηχανισμό λειτουργίας του Κέντρου: υπηρεσίες αποκατάστασης, υπηρεσίες ένταξης και υπηρεσίες εξεύρεσης βιώσιμης λύσης.

Συγκεκριμένα, το Κέντρο στόχο έχει να παρέχει σε ασυνόδευτους ανηλίκους ένα σύνολο διεπιστημονικών και ολιστικών υπηρεσιών, όπως ψυχολογική, κοινωνική και νομική συμβουλευτική υποστήριξη, υποστηρικτικές υπηρεσίες ένταξης και πρόσβασης στη δημόσια εκπαίδευση, εργαστήρια σεξουαλικής διαπαιδαγώγησης και μαθήματα ελληνικών, αγγλικών, μουσικής και γυμναστική, για τα οποία υπεύθυνος είναι ο εταίρος του έργου, το Πολυδύναμο Κέντρο Δήμου Λευκωσίας. Το Κέντρο προσφέ-

ρει τις υπηρεσίες του με βάση μοντέλα που θεωρούνται καλές πρακτικές σε άλλα κράτη μέλη της Ευρωπαϊκής Ένωσης, μοντέλα προσαρμοσμένα στα δεδομένα της Κύπρου.

AMIF project: Household-skills training for refugees (FI/2016/PR/1540)



Since the 2015 refugee crisis, a large number of refugees have settled in municipalities around Finland.

Most refugees leaving reception centres once they are granted asylum settle in large cities, especially in and around Helsinki, which has caused a serious housing shortage.

The project team planned and carried out household-skills training for newly arrived refugees, especially families and young adults with little experience running a household. The training sessions and one-on-one lessons were designed to increase immigrants' life skills and understanding of living in Finland.

The project's aim was to prevent homelessness and other housing-related problems among young refugees and refugee families.

Teaching refugees the skills needed for independent living is an important aspect

of integration into their new home country and opens up opportunities for discussion on other issues. The model for household-skills training developed in the project will be shared in order for other actors to be able to use it as well.

AMIF-projekti: Pakolaisten asumisvalmennus kaupungeissa (FI/2016/PR/1540)

Vuoden 2015 pakolaiskriisin myötä kuntiin on siirtynyt suuri määrä oleskeluluvan saaneita pakolaistaustaisia maahanmuuttajia. Pakolaisten turvapaikkaprosessin jälkeen muuttoliike vastaanottokeskuksista suuriin kaupunkeihin ja erityisesti pääkaupunkiseudulle on voimakkainta, mikä on johtanut suureen asunnontarpeeseen.

Hankkeessa luodaan ja toteutetaan asumisvalmennuksia varhaisen vaiheen pakolaistaustaisille maahanmuuttajille, kohteena erityisesti lapsiperheet ja nuoret aikuiset, joiden itsenäisen asumisen valmiudet eivät ole riittävät. Val-

mennuksen ja siihen kytkeytyvän yksilötyön avulla pyritään vahvistamaan pakolaisasiakkaiden asumistaitoja sekä tietoa asumisesta Suomessa.

Tavoitteena on ennaltaehkäistä pakolaistaustaisten nuorten ja lapsiperheiden asunnottomuutta sekä muita asumisen ongelmia.

Asumisen asioissa opastaminen on tärkeä osa uuteen maahan kotoutumista ja avaa keskustelua muille aiheille. Hankkeessa tuotettava asumisvalmennusmalli on myös muiden toimijoiden käytössä jatkossa.



AMIF project: Accelair – accelerating refugees' integration (FAMI-I/A-17-450)

Since 2002, thanks to the Accelair project, more than 9 000 beneficiaries of international protection have been integrated into the Rhône department. From 2017, Accelair has also been established in nine other departments in France.

All beneficiaries of international protection are eligible, whether they are in a residential centre or not.

Accelair is based on several principles, as explained below.

- Comprehensive, individual, specialised and personalised 24-month-long support for access to rights, housing, training and employment.
- A partnership system (institutional and associative): all organisations involved in asylum-related activities are Accelair partners – such as NGOs, local authorities, social landlords and employment actors.
- Supplementing common law: due to the extreme diversity of the public, not all needs can be covered by common law. Accelair therefore complements and reinforces it by setting up integration schemes.

Projet FAMI: Accelair – Accélérer l'intégration des réfugiés

(FAMI-I/A-17-450)

Depuis 2002, grâce à Accelair, plus de 9 000 bénéficiaires d'une protection internationale (BPI) ont été intégrés au sein du département du Rhône. À partir de 2017, Accelair s'est également implanté dans neuf autres départements français.

Accelair repose sur plusieurs principes:

- un accompagnement global, individuel, spécialisé et personnalisé de 24 mois pour l'accès aux droits, au logement, à la formation et à l'emploi;
- un système de partenariat (institutionnel et associatif): toutes les parties impliquées

dans les activités liées à l'asile sont des partenaires Accelair, comme les organisations non gouvernementales (ONG), les autorités locales, les bailleurs sociaux et les acteurs de l'emploi;

- une complémentarité avec le droit commun: du fait de l'extrême hétérogénéité du public, tous les besoins ne peuvent être couverts par le droit commun. Accelair intervient alors pour le compléter et le renforcer en mettant en place des actions d'intégration.

Tous les BPI sont éligibles, qu'ils soient en centre d'hébergement ou non.



AMIF project: The Pause programme – national programme for the urgent aid and reception of scientists in exile (FAMI-I-18-554)

The national programme for the urgent aid and reception of scientists in exile (Pause) is implemented by the Collège de France. Its aim is to take in scientists – at higher education and public research establishments – who come from third countries with a political situation that endangers their lives and their families' lives and no longer allows them to work. Funding mobilised by the host institutions and the Pause programme supports a system of reception and access to employment that allows beneficiaries to gain a year's experience, which can be renewed once, in teaching or scientific research. The project also provides for linguistic schemes (French courses) and access to rights (administrative procedures for obtaining a residence permit or accommodation).

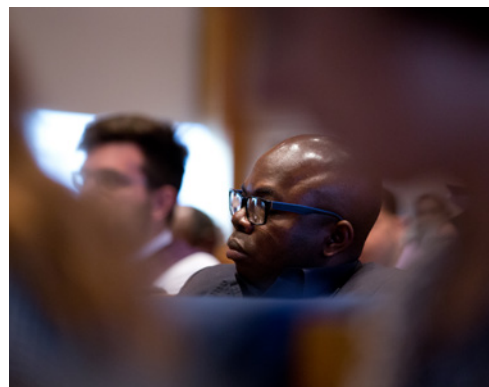


Projet FAMI: PAUSE (programme national d'accueil en urgence des scientifiques en exil) (FAMI-I-18-554)



Le programme national d'accueil en urgence des scientifiques en exil (PAUSE) est mis en œuvre par le Collège de France. Ce projet vise à accueillir dans des établissements de l'enseignement supérieur et de la recherche publics, les scientifiques ressortissants de pays tiers, provenant de pays où la situation politique ne leur permet plus d'exercer leur métier et met leur vie et celle de leur famille en danger. Des financements mobilisés par les établissements d'accueil et par PAUSE soutiennent un dispositif d'installation et d'accès à l'emploi permettant à ces bénéficiaires de s'insérer pour une année, renouvelable une fois, dans les métiers de l'enseignement et de la recherche scientifique. Le projet prévoit également des actions linguistiques (cours de français langue étrangère) et

d'accès aux droits (démarches administratives liées à l'obtention d'un titre de séjour ou à un logement).



AMIF project: Speaking get-togethers – for integration in the countryside (DE/2017/PR/3436)

The 'speaking get together – for integration in the countryside' project offered supplementary general and job-specific language courses for immigrant third-country nationals in rural areas. The aim was to increase their chances of participation in society and to support their integration into the labour market. Public 'language meeting places' were established at locations in four federal states as information, language learning and meeting places, which were conceived as first points of contact for language acquisition and as a supplement to nationally offered courses. The project's distinguishing feature was its trained volunteers working with the refugees as language and reading mentors or tandem partners. Computer workstations and selected media (books, CDs, online courses, etc.) were made available for supported and individual learning. Structurally, the pilot project contributed to expanding local and regional networks in order to create synergies and strengthen work on integration in rural areas.

AMIF-Projekt: Sprachtreff – für Integration auf dem Land

(DE/2017/PR/3436)

„Sprachtreff – für Integration auf dem Land“ bietet ergänzende allgemeine und berufsbezogene Sprachförderung für zugewanderte Drittstaatsangehörige im ländlichen Raum. Ziel ist es, ihre Partizipationschancen in der Gesellschaft zu erhöhen und sie bei der Integration in den Beruf zu unterstützen. Öffentliche „Sprachtreffs“ werden an Standorten in vier Bundesländern als Informations-, Sprachlern- und Begegnungsorte etabliert, die sich als erste Anlaufstellen für den Spracherwerb und als Ergänzung zu den gesetzlich eingeführten Kursen verstehen. Die Besonderheit des Projekts ist, dass geschulte Ehrenamtliche als Sprach- und Lesepaten bzw. Tandem-Partner die Geflüchteten begleiten. Computerarbeitsplatz und ausgewählte Medien (Bücher, CDs, Online-Kurse usw.) stehen zum unterstützten sowie individuellen Lernen zur Verfügung. Strukturell trägt das Modellprojekt dazu bei, lokale und regionale Netzwerke

auszubauen, um Synergien zu schaffen und die Integrationsarbeit im ländlichen Raum zu stärken.



AMIF project: Cabuwazi Welcome Circus (DE/2017/PR/3597)

The Cabuwazi Welcome Circus project brought circus-skills activities to residential facilities for refugees in order to enable children, teenagers and young adults to experience their first, positive contact with the new environment and the German language. This outreach work, complemented by accompanying parental work, set in motion and prepared the refugees' future integration, facilitating and laying the groundwork for the subsequent inclusion-oriented work in the circus ring of the Cabuwazi Children's and Youth Circus at Tempelhofer Feld in Berlin. Here, both local residents and refugees rehearsed together for a large public circus show. The refugees received comprehensive personal, social and linguistic skills development and learned to participate in the community and in day-to-day life in society, outside their isolated home environment.

Το πρώτο έργο αποβλέπει στην ενδυνάμωση και στήριξη του ανθρώπινου δυναμικού της Υπηρεσίας Ασύλου με σκοπό την ενίσχυση της πρόσβασης των αιτούντων διεθνή προστασία στις διαδικασίες υποβολής και εξέτασης των αιτημάτων τους και την ενίσχυση της επιχειρησιακής ικανότητας της Υπηρεσίας Ασύλου.

Το δεύτερο έργο συμβάλλει στη διευκόλυνση της πρόσβασης των αιτούντων άσυλο στις διαδικασίες ασύλου, σε υπηρεσίες διερμηνείας και

μετάφρασης, δράσεις ενημέρωσης και υπηρεσίες συμβουλευτικής υποστήριξης. Υποστηρίζει επίσης τη μεταφορά αιτούντων διεθνή προστασία σε κράτος μέλος που προσδιορίζεται ως υπεύθυνο για την εξέταση αιτήσεων διεθνούς προστασίας που υποβάλλονται στην Ελλάδα από υπηκόους τρίτης χώρας ή από απάτριδες. AMIF project: Provision of legal aid and representation and clearance of the pending cases under the previous asylum system

The aim of the first project is to strengthen the asylum procedure in terms of the provision of legal assistance. Fixed-term contract staff are assigned to the Coordination Department as coordinators and managers of the action and the registry of lawyers. Moreover, the Asylum Service provides free legal assistance in the second instance of the administrative procedures and in the proceedings before the committees.

The purpose of the second project is to clear the asylum cases pending at the second instance. These cases are examined by 20 committees set up for this purpose, which have been operating since 3 June 2013. Following the committees' reviews, joint ministerial decisions are issued. To date, further joint ministerial decisions have been adopted, continuing the work of the com-

mittees. The action includes the procurement of equipment and supplies and security measures.

AMIF έργο: Νομική συνδρομή και εκπροσώπηση + Υποστήριξη της εκκαθάρισης συσσωρευμένων προσφυγών της διαδικασίας ασύλου στην Ελλάδα



Σκοπός του πρώτου έργου είναι η ενίσχυση της διαδικασίας ασύλου, ως προς την παροχή νομικής συνδρομής. Στο πλαίσιο αυτό, προσλαμβάνεται προσωπικό στο Τμήμα Συντονισμού με σχέση εργασίας ιδιωτικού δικαίου ορισμένου χρόνου, το οποίο τοποθετείται σε θέσεις συντονισμού και διαχείρισης της δράσης και του μπρώου δικηγόρων. Επίσης, η Υπηρεσία Ασύλου παρέχει δωρεάν νομική συνδρομή στο πλαίσιο της δεύτερης φάσης της διοικητικής διαδικασίας και στις διαδικασίες ενώπιον των Επιτροπών.

Στόχος του δεύτερου έργου είναι να εκκαθαριστούν υποθέσεις ασύλου που εκκρεμούν στη δεύτερη φάση. Η εξέταση διενεργείται από 20 επιτροπές που έχουν συγκροτηθεί για τον σκοπό αυτό και οι οποίες άρχισαν να λειτουργούν από τις 3 Ιουνίου 2013. Με βάση τις εκθέσεις των επιτροπών, εκδίδονται κοινές υπουργικές αποφάσεις. Μέχρι σήμερα έχουν εκδοθεί και άλλες κοινές υπουργικές αποφάσεις για τη συνέχιση της λειτουργίας των Επιτροπών. Στο πλαίσιο της δράσης συμπεριλαμβάνεται η προμήθεια εξοπλισμού και αναλωσίμων και η λήψη μέτρων ασφαλείας.

AMIF project: Hungarian assisted voluntary return, reintegration and information programme for migrants (HU/2018/PR/0003)

During the implementation of this project, the target group was provided with information on the possibility of voluntary return, potentially supplemented by reintegration support, as well as on the related services involved in organising voluntary returns.

This expansion of the vehicle fleet allows the safe and humane transportation of persons undergoing immigration proceedings, persons who have been expelled or detained or persons to be repatriated.

The Spiritan Asylum Services Initiative (Spirasi) works with asylum seekers, refugees and other disadvantaged migrant groups. It aims to rehabilitate survivors of torture by providing medical, therapeutic, social and educational assistance.

Spirasi provides a range of services to victims of torture nationally, including:

- an initial assessment of victims of torture;
- medical and legal reports for the protection process;
- therapeutic services, including individual, group and family therapy;
- psychosocial and transitional/integration support services;
- outreach support in accommodation centres across Ireland;
- classes in English language, information technology literacy, numeracy and other subjects, such as art, music and gardening;
- social events and a welcoming environment for refugees and asylum seekers.

to increase opportunities for cultural and social integration and to educate the public.

At the end of the project, the living conditions of persons granted asylum will have been improved and the staff of social integration institutions will have gained constructive experience in mutual cooperation. Through the project, persons granted asylum who have participated in joint meetings with members of the public will be able to continue to seek more direct contact and closer cooperation with various public influence groups in the future; they will be more confident in their ability to influence the integration process themselves. The authorities and the public will be able to hear the problems and issues of persons granted asylum directly.

Aims of the project. To establish appropriate conditions for the reception and accommodation of asylum seekers at the Foreigners' Registration Centre; to improve reception conditions for vulnerable asylum seekers.

Project activities/components. Preparation of the design, technical specifications, construction and installations for the building; arrangement of the area surrounding the new building, outdoor recreation games and children's playgrounds, fitness complex, gazebo with table and benches, walkways and lighting.

Expected results. A building that can accommodate 15 people and is suitable for people with reduced mobility.

What makes this project particularly interesting? The building constructed during the project provides adequate housing and hygiene conditions to vulnerable asylum seekers, includ-

ing those with special needs related to reduced mobility. There is the option to accommodate vulnerable asylum seekers separately according to their religion and nationality.

AMIF project: Let's talk about health – sexual, emotional and reproductive health (LU/2017/PR/0006)



The 'let's talk about health' project aimed to integrate, empower and promote the well-being of populations seeking and benefiting from international protection in Luxembourg.

During information sessions known as 'workshops' or 'health cafés', women, men and young people were able to engage in friendly exchange and confidence-building on the topics of sexual, reproductive, emotional and psychological health, rights and current values and social codes, while sharing snacks in an intercultural environment, thanks to a pool of interpreters trained on and open to the topics covered.

The services of the Family Planning organisation are complemented by tools and multimedia resources tested with refugees, bilingual health booklets, audio and video presentations, etc. A remote interpreting service (via an audio conference platform) is also available. It gives applicants for international protection and beneficiaries of international protection the opportunity to consult with family planning counsellors in their preferred language, after making an appointment online.

This work on informing and raising awareness with the people concerned strengthens both their capacities to take charge of, and behave in ways beneficial to, their health, and their well-being and empowerment.

Projet AMIF: Parlons santé — sexuelle, reproductive et affective (LU/2017/PR/0006)

Le projet «Parlons santé» vise l'intégration, l'autonomisation et le bien-être des populations demandeuses et bénéficiaires d'une protection internationale (DPI et BPI) accueillies au Luxembourg.

Au cours de séances d'information «ateliers ou cafés santé», les femmes, les hommes et les adolescents vivent des moments conviviaux d'échanges et de mise en confiance autour de la santé sexuelle, reproductive, affective et psychologique, des droits, valeurs et codes sociaux en vigueur, tout en partageant un goût interculturel, avec l'aide d'un pool d'interprètes formés et ouverts aux thématiques abordées.

Les services du planning familial sont complétés par des outils et supports multimédias testés avec des personnes réfugiées: livrets de santé bilingues, animations audio et vidéo, etc. Un service d'interprétation à distance (via une plateforme d'audioconférence) est également disponible. Il donne la possibilité aux DPI et BPI de consulter les conseillers du planning familial dans la langue de communication de leur choix, après avoir pris rendez-vous en ligne.

Ce travail d'information et de sensibilisation auprès des personnes concernées renforce leurs capacités à prendre en charge et à adopter des comportements favorables à leur santé ainsi qu'à leur bien-être et à leur autonomisation.



AMIF project: Peer training for shared integration

(LU/2016/PR/0017)



This project aimed to provide an approach to the integration of young immigrants based on informal education and peer training. By offering young newcomers the opportunity to raise awareness among their peers of integration issues through informal education workshops, they take an active role in society and commit to learning to better live together. This helps to facilitate their own integration.

The project was structured around awareness-raising workshops on the promotion of integration and diversity led by 4motion in schools. The pupils the most interested in the method (the informal education approach) or the topics took part in training that allowed them to host their own activities with other young people with the support of 4motion, such as workshops or street performances.

The results obtained were in line with expectations: 52 young people were trained, and have facilitated more than 20 activities (some have started their own projects); eight schools were partners in the project and more than 1 000 young people were made aware of the issues of shared integration.

Over the course of the project, a group of about 50 young diversity ambassadors was formed (representing more than 25 different nationalities). This group was supported in setting up

different activities. It represented an opportunity for each newcomer to learn, socialise and adapt. The newcomers had the chance to draw on the peer group for all kinds of support: useful information, places and associations to discover, encouragement, moral support, adverts for student jobs, etc. The most active members have even been able to benefit from European mobility opportunities.

Projet AMIF: «Peer training», pour une intégration partagée (LU/2016/PR/0017)

Le projet ambitionne d'apporter une nouvelle façon de concevoir l'intégration des jeunes immigrés basée sur l'éducation non formelle et la transmission par les pairs. En offrant la possibilité aux jeunes nouveaux arrivants de sensibiliser leurs pairs aux questions de l'intégration à travers des ateliers sur l'éducation non formelle, ils prennent un rôle actif dans la société et s'engagent pour un meilleur vivre-ensemble. Cela contribue à faciliter leur propre intégration.

Le projet s'articule autour d'ateliers de sensibilisation à l'intégration et à la diversité animés par 4motion dans les écoles. Les élèves les plus intéressés par la méthode (approche non formelle de l'éducation) ou par les thèmes prennent part à une formation qui leur permet par la suite d'animer leurs propres activités avec d'autres jeunes avec l'accompagnement de 4motion: ateliers, animations de rue, etc.

Les résultats obtenus ont été conformes à nos attentes: 52 jeunes ont été formés. Ils ont animé plus de 20 activités (certains ont lancé leurs propres projets). Huit écoles ont été partenaires du projet et plus de 1 000 jeunes ont été sensibilisés aux enjeux de l'intégration partagée.

Tout au long du projet, un groupe d'une cinquantaine de jeunes «ambassadeurs de la diversité» s'est formé (plus de 25 nationalités différentes étaient représentées). Ce groupe a été accompagné dans la mise en place de différentes activités. Il a représenté un espace d'apprentissage, de socialisation et d'adaptation pour chaque nouveau venu. Chacun pouvait puiser toutes sortes de ressources dans le groupe de pairs: des informations utiles, des endroits à découvrir, des associations à connaître, de la motivation, du soutien moral, des annonces pour des jobs étudiants, etc. Les jeunes les plus actifs au sein du projet ont même pu bénéficier d'opportunités de mobilité européenne.



AMIF project: Learning – exchanging – integrating (MT/2017/PR/1001)



This project supports the implementation of the migrant integration strategy and action plan (Vision 2020) issued by the project beneficiary on behalf of the government of Malta in December 2017. The beneficiary also set up the basic structure of the Integration Unit laid out in the national AMIF programme and in the strategy. The project engages human resources to allow the unit to commence operations. The revamped Inter-Ministerial Committee began meeting again in January 2018. The strategy's 'I belong' programme is supported by the Stage 1 courses (on language, civics and social orientation, aimed at non-Maltese EU nationals, third-country nationals, refugees, asylum seekers and beneficiaries of international protection), provided by the Malta College of Arts, Science and Technology. Other action plan measures supported by this project will be the local councils' charter-related measures and networking with migrant communities, international organisations and NGOs. The project also contains confidence-building awareness

campaigns, such as adverts at bus stops, stickers, online advertising and video clip production. It will also support events such as an annual cultural event, migrant integration information sessions (for migrants) and an annual activity day for children.

The Green Way heeft tot doel om Armeense gezinnen in Nederland te stimuleren vrijwillig terug te keren. Ouders worden samen met hun kinderen in Nederland begeleid bij het terugkeerproces. ”Lobben – utbildning och ledarskap” skulle främja etableringen och integrationen av asylsökande i Jämtland-Härjedalens, Gävleborgs och Västernorrlands län. Målgruppen var i huvudsak asylsökande kvinnor och män från 18 år.

Genom att ge asylsökande ett socialt sammanhang inom idrottsrörelsen erbjöds möjlighet till utbildning, utveckling och inkludering. Utbildningen inom ledarskap syftade till att ge deltagarna utvecklade färdigheter i ledarskap samtidigt som den gynnade deras språkinläring och erbjöd dem ett större nätverk. En central målsättning var att genom en meningsfull fritid öka deltagarnas självkänsla och självförtroende. Förhoppningen var att språkinläringen på så sätt skulle bli mer effektiv och att deltagarna snabbare skulle etableras i samhället. Genom att kombinera praktiskt ledarskap inom fören-

ingslivet med idrottens ledarskapsutbildningar fick deltagarna möjlighet att varva kompetensutveckling inom ledarskap, värdegrundsarbete, jämställdhet och personlig utveckling med praktiska moment ute i föreningarna.



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
