REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 19.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 19 of the Streets and Buildings Regulation Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following regulations :

1. These regulations may be cited as the Streets and Buildings (Amendment) Regulations, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Streets and Buildings Regulations, 1946 to (No. 2) 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Streets and Buildings Regulations, 1946 to 1954.

Paragraph 2 of regulation 62 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "Councils of the Municipal Corporations of Nicosia and Limassol" (as set out in regulation 2 of the Streets and Buildings (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1949) and the substitution therefor of the words "Councils of the Municipal Corporations of Nicosia, Limassol and Larnaca".

3. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part II (as set out in regulation 3 of the Streets and Buildings (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1949) and the substitution therefor of the following Part :—
